If you are an Intellectual Property owner we encourage you to join our Verified Rights Owner (VeRO)<sup>™</sup> Program, which was created to help intellectual property owners protect their rights by facilitating and simplifying the searching, reporting and removal of infringing items on our site. Program membership requires only that you complete and sign the attached Notice of Infringement. We cannot remove items without a Notice of Infringement in proper form.

You will need to provide a Notice of Infringement form each time you wish to report alleged acts of infringement. Your first Notice of Infringement should be faxed to +91-22-66690003. For quicker processing you may fax your Notice to 001-408516 8811 for the United States. After we receive your first notice by fax, so long as subsequent Notices of Infringement are reported by an authorised person from the same company or firm, future notices can be sent to us by email at a special email address we will give you for your convenience. Such email notifications must contain substantially the same information as is contained in our form.

If the identified listings are ended at your request, eBay will notify the seller and bidders by email of that fact and provide them with the IP Owner's name and email address (which you provide) as well as eBay's email address in the event of a dispute.
